1. God knows our troubles (Vs 1-4).

Matthew 10:28, “And fear not them which kill the body, but are not able to kill the soul: but rather fear him which is able to destroy both soul and body in hell.

2. God hears our prayer (Vs. 5-17).

Psalm 46:10, “Be still, and know that I am God:
I will be exalted among the heathen, I will be
exalted in the earth.”

1 Thessalonians 5:17, “Pray without ceasing.”

Philippians 4:6-7, “⁶ Be careful for nothing; but in every thing by prayer and supplication with thanksgiving let your requests be made known unto God. ⁷ And the peace of God, which passeth all understanding, shall keep your hearts and minds through Christ Jesus.”

Mark 9:24, “And straightway the father of the child cried out, and said with tears, Lord, I believe; help thou mine unbelief.”

3. God is not mocked (Vs. 18-25).

Galatians 6:7, “Be not deceived; God is not mocked: for whatsoever a man soweth, that shall he also reap.”

Psalm 145:20, “The Lord preserveth all them that love him: But all the wicked will he destroy.”

1 Peter 3:12, “¹² For the eyes of the Lord *are* over the righteous, and his ears *are open* unto their prayers: but the face of the Lord *is* against them that do evil.”

Revelation 20:15, “And whosoever was not found written in the book of life was cast into the lake of fire.”
